.....Preamble.....

Curl Manitoba is currently undergoing a review of all of our Provincial Championships. The Provincial Championships that will be reviewed are the Masters (m & w), Seniors (m & w), Women's (Scotties) Men's (Safeway), Mixed, and Juniors (m & w). There are multiple goals of this review:  
To help us determine the overall goal of each championship  
To determine the most effective, efficient and fair way of qualifying for Provincial championships  
To determine the most effective, efficient and fair way of running our Provincial Championships

Our expectation is at the end of the review we will have determined a Provincial Championship and Provincial Championship Qualifying process that will meet the needs of all our stakeholders, curlers, curling club, organizers, and host committee's, media, sponsors, officials and Curl Manitoba.

In order to conduct this review Curl Manitoba has struck an ad hoc committee that has been given the task of conducting the review on each category. This committee will consist of two representatives from Curl Manitoba, one female over 50 one female under 50, one male over 50 one male under 50 and 2 at large members. This main committee will determine the best way of reviewing each of the Championships. This might include forming a sub-committee, conducting survey's, hosting a "town hall" meeting etc.

At the end of the review we anticipate that each Championship and qualifying process will be designed and implemented according to the needs of its individual stakeholders and that each Championship and qualifying process may be different.

While we do not want to rush this process we will move forward as quickly as possible. A change in a Championship will only be implemented once the Committee has completed its due diligence, prepared and presented a recommendation to the Curl Manitoba Board and this recommendation is approved by the Board.
